

## **The Netherlands: Exception to our standard purchase conditions**

The information below applies only to suppliers of Coca-Cola Europacific Partners Nederland B.V. The standard payment terms are described in the standard purchasing conditions. Exceptions are described below.

### **Exceptions for small and medium-sized suppliers (SMEs)**

For small and medium-sized suppliers (SME), we deviate from our standard purchase conditions and apply a shorter payment term of 30 days, meaning that CCEP will pay all correct invoices within 30 days of receiving a correct invoice. If the payment date falls on a weekend or public holiday, payment will be made on the next business day.

A supplier qualifies as small or medium-sized (SME) if it meets at least two of the following legal requirements in accordance with Article 6:119a(6) of the Dutch Civil Code and Articles 2:395a to 2:398 of the Dutch Civil Code:

1. Value of assets according to balance sheet does not exceed €20,000,000;
2. Net turnover for financial year does not exceed €40,000,000;
3. Average number of employees during the financial year is less than 250.

### **The above is supported by the following documentation:**

1. Most recent financial statements showing compliance with the above requirements, signed by a duly authorized person;
2. An official document describing the company's workforce (including employees, seconded persons, owner-managers and partners), signed by a duly authorized person;
3. A signed copy of the application form
